General Description of Position	Under the direction of the Donation Center Manager (when working in the Donation Center) the Facilities Specialist (FS) will carry out basic facility maintenance, donation processing (receiving/sorting/testing/pricing donations).
Essential Duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Will be responsible for overseeing loading of pass on trailer, emptying trash/cardboard, lifting bags/boxes for volunteers/staff ▪ Assist with general building maintenance- shovel snow, replace lightbulbs, keep storage areas organized, etc. ▪ Assist donors in a positive, professional manner ▪ Know and politely enforce policies regarding donations ▪ Know and adhere to standards of quality guidelines for sorting ▪ Test donated electronics and sporting goods ▪ Price merchandise for the thrift store as directed ▪ Assist with special projects and perform other duties as assigned ▪ Rotate seasonal merchandise and prepare donations for recycling ▪ Maintain a clean, organized and safe work site ▪ Receive incoming calls and transfer as needed ▪ Oversee volunteers at work site in the absence of the manager ▪ Provide coverage in the thrift store as needed (run and balance cash register; assist customers) ▪ Attend monthly staff meetings
